Request denied by (treasurer), submitted treasurer debit receipt amount $\$ 157.50$ which cheque \# _9_ was issued. Upon investigation with Kernels the $\$ 157.50$ were used to purchase gift cards 20X $\$ 5$ and 1X $\$ 57.50$ investigated with her work and gave $\$ 57.50$ cash back on behalf of her work on June 27th. Denise asked Kernals Head office for the remaining 20 gift cards to be deactivated since it is the last day of school and no response on where the money is. Kernals replied to Denise's request and $\$ 100$ was credited to Carleton PAC on Kernal's account used in 1st order for October.
